

**Notification pursuant to article 8 of the Law on Insurance Mediation:
Free movement of services**

Insurance intermediaries licensed in Liechtenstein who intend to start business for the first time in another Member State of the European Economic Area under the rules on the freedom to provide services must notify the FMA of this intention by means of this form.

The FMA will inform the competent supervisory authority in the host Member State – if the host Member State requires this – within one month. The FMA will provide notice to the insurance intermediary that the FMA has informed the competent supervisory authority. Upon expiry of one month after receipt of this notice, the insurance intermediary may start business in the country in question.

If the host Member State does not require prior information concerning the intention to engage in cross-border business (see list of the EEA Member States requiring notification at <http://www.fma-li.li/>), then the insurance intermediary may start business as soon as he/she has notified the intention to the FMA by means of this form.
